School Lunch Online is an Australian online platform designed to streamline the process of ordering school lunches and P&C Fundraising. It connects parents, schools and suppliers to ensure students receive healthy and tasty meals with minimal hassle.

Benefits to families

- An easy to use, flexible and secure online platform
- Plan, place and pay for orders online
- Healthy, tasty and cost effective lunch options with lots of variety on offer
- No minimum order or long term commitment

Benefits to the school

- Absolutely no cost to the school
- No administration for collecting late orders or payments made to incorrect bank accounts
- Reduced time for admin team to scribe missed manual orders
- Direct involvement with menu options

Benefits for the P&C

- Enhances operational efficiency by reducing cash handling and streamlining order management, allowing the P&C to focus elsewhere
- Simplified distribution system via common labeling system

Frequency

- For the foreseeable future, we will continue with lunch orders once per fortnight.
- These will mostly fall on a Friday, with the occasional Thursday where there are conflicting events.

Who is the Food Supplier?

- Theme Group is the registered supplier with School Lunches Online and are located in Malaga.
- All food is Halal.

Food Delivery

- Theme Group deliver the lunches to USPS and parent volunteers then distribute orders to students from the canteen.
- Lunches for kindy and pre-primary students are delivered directly to classrooms.

Order Deadlines & Cancellation

- Orders close at 6am on the day prior to delivery. Orders for Friday lunches will close on Thursday 6am, and orders for Thursday will close on Wednesday 6am. After the orders have closed, they will not be refundable.
- In the event your child is absent or sick on a lunch day, you will have the option to collect it, pass onto a sibling or donate to another student who may be without.

Allergen Advice

- Theme Group is not a nut free facility however there will be no nut products in our menu. They work towards minimising the risk of cross contamination.

How do lunch orders support your P&C?

- All orders incur a \$0.25 fee payable to School Lunch Online. There will also be an additional \$1.00 per order which will go directly towards your P&C. These fees will be visible to parents for transparency.
