Upcycling Art – Grocery Bag Self-Portraits 🎨♻️

The children explored creativity and sustainability during our upcycling art activity by transforming old grocery bags into unique canvases. Using paint, markers and mixed craft materials, they designed colourful self-portraits that reflected their personalities. This activity encouraged imagination, self-expression and conversations about reusing everyday materials to care for our environment.

Our craft table was full of excitement as the children designed their own masks and puppets using a variety of materials such as paper, fabric, craft sticks and decorations. Each creation had its own personality and story! This activity supported creative thinking, storytelling and fine motor skills as the children cut, glued and assembled their designs.

Cool Creations in the Shade 🌞🌿

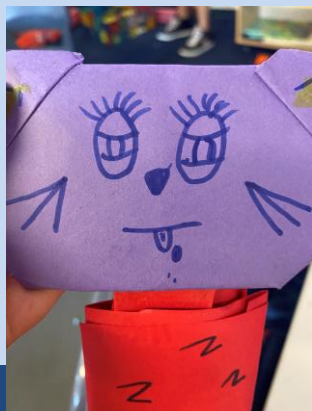

Working in small groups, the children enjoyed relaxed creative session of making slime. The session encouraged teamwork, patience and problem-solving while the children collaborated and shared ideas.

Minecraft Iron Bead Creations 🟩🌟

One of the most popular activities of the week was creating Minecraft characters and colourful keyrings using iron beads. The children carefully followed patterns and designed their own pixel-style creations before the beads were fused together. This activity helped develop concentration, pattern recognition and fine motor skills while allowing the children to bring their favourite game characters to life.

Science Fun – Fizzy Ice Cube Experiment 🧊💧

Science was full of excitement as the children geared up to become scientists for the afternoon! We explored fizzy ice cubes made by freezing water, bicarbonate soda and food colouring. The children tested different ingredients to see which ones would make the cubes fizz and melt. This hands-on experiment encouraged curiosity, prediction and observation as the children discovered how different substances react together.

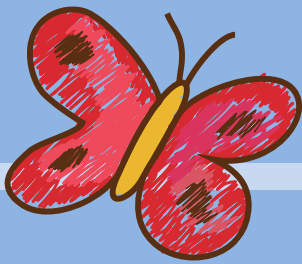
